
## MAISIE ADDING A SLEEVE CUFF



To make a cuff, cut TWO pieces the following sizes:

Size SMALL (8-10) = (A) 10cm x (B) 24cm Size MED (12-14) = (A) 10cm x (B) 26.5cm Size LARGE (16-18) = (A) 10cm x (B) 29cm Size XL (20-22) = (A) 10cm x (B) 31.5cm Size 2XL (24-26) = (A) 10cm x (B) 34cm

1. With the RST (right sides together), fold each cuff piece in half so the short sides are matching. Pin. Sew. Press the seam allowances open.



2. Fold the cuff 'ring' piece in half with the wrong sides facing together, aligning the raw edges. Press.

3. Pin one cuff to the sleeve raw edge right side, aligning the raw edges. Sew. (Hand tack first if you prefer). Finish the raw edges together.

Press the seam allowances towards the sleeve.

Repeat for the other cuff piece.
